

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. How do I register?

A. To guarantee a spot in the league, you must promptly register as part of team. To register as a team, someone must first volunteer to serve as a coach. The coach must then: (1) collect signed Player Registration Forms from at least ten players; (2) collect \$90 checks made payable to "BETTERBALL!, Inc." from each player; and (3) complete and sign a Team Registration Form. The coach must send all of the registration materials to: BETTERBALL!, Inc., 818 Homestead Avenue, Havertown, PA 19083.

Q. Can I register individually and not part as a team?

A. Yes, but you will not be guaranteed a spot in the league. To register individually, you should send a Player Registration Form and a \$90 check made payable to "BETTERBALL!, Inc." to BETTERBALL!, Inc., 818 Homestead Avenue, Havertown, PA 19083. If the league receives a sufficient number of individual registrations, it will attempt to form a team.

Q. How many teams will play in the League?

A. Our goal is to have six teams in the second grade division, six teams in the third grade division, and six teams in the fourth grade division. Registration materials will be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis for each division.

Q. When are the registration materials due?

A. Registration materials must be submitted by November 6, 2009.

Q. Are there any restrictions on forming teams?

A. Yes. Teams must consist of players who attend no more than two different schools. There are no exceptions. This rule is designed to create a League with balanced teams and to prevent unfair recruiting.

Q. Do the players receive uniforms?

A. Yes. Each player will receive a uniform before league play begins.

Q. Where are the games?

A. All of the games will be held at The Haverford School Field House. The Haverford School is located at 450 Lancaster Avenue, Haverford, PA 19041.

Q. When are the games?

A. League play will begin on Saturday, December 5, 2009. Games will be played on Saturday mornings between December 2009 and February 2010.

Q. How many games does each team play?

A. Ten. Our goal is for each team to play the other five teams in its division twice.

Q. What size basketball will the players use?

A. Players in all three divisions will use a standard Women's 28.5" basketball.

Q. What is the height of the basket?

A. The second and third grade divisions will use eight and a half feet baskets. The fourth grade division will use ten feet baskets.

Q. How can I find out if a game is cancelled because of bad weather?

A. Check the BETTERBALL! Web site or contact your coach. If games are cancelled for any reason, the League will post the cancellation on this Web site and notify your coach via email.
