



2011-2012 BASKETBALL LEAGUE

Girls: 3rd & 4th Grade
Boys: 2nd, 3rd & 4th Grade

League Description:

The BETTERBALL! League is a SCHOOL league with players forming a team with boys or girls from their school/parish. Players may join together with kids from one other school/parish if they are having trouble getting a full team together. League games are played December-February. The league will be divided into five divisions and games will be played at the locations described below:

- 2nd grade boys – games played at The Haverford School
- 3rd grade girls – games played at The Haverford School
- 3rd grade boys – games played at The Haverford School
- 4th grade girls – games played at Cabrini College
- 4th grade boys – games played at Cabrini College

Schedule changes due to weather may necessitate games being played on other days of the week in order to complete the schedule. All teams will play 10 games. Grade 2 will play on 8' rims, Grade 3 will play on 9' rims, Grade 4 will play on 10' rims.

Registration Instructions:

Coaches must complete the team registration form (page 2) and submit it via email (kath@betterball.net) or mail (BETTERBALL, 818 Homestead Ave, Havertown, PA 19083). Coaches will then receive a link for their players to register individually online. No player will be permitted to compete until they have registered online. Teams must consist of at least 10 players (minimum \$900 per team).

Fees:

The fee is \$90 per player, due upon completing the online player registration form. Players who register after November 13th will be charged a \$10 late fee. There is a \$10 sibling discount once one sibling is paid in full.

Deadlines:

October 21 – Team registration forms due. The first six teams per division to submit their team registration form will be accepted to the league. After six teams have registered, any additional teams will be placed on a waiting list.

November 13 - Player online registration and payment due. After November 13th, players will be charged a \$10 late fee.

Practices:

It is the responsibility of each team to schedule their own practices.
